	<p><b>Keeping Children Safe</b></p> <p>If you need to speak to your child's class teacher and you don't catch them on the playground before the bell goes, please come to the front office and arrange to meet the class teacher at the end of the day. This way they can give more time to your concerns. 	<p><b>School Nurse – Drop In Session -ALL WELCOME</b></p> <p>The school nurse will be in school for a drop-in session on <b>Thursday 22nd June 8.45am-9.45am</b>. This is a great opportunity to come and talk to the nurse about any health concerns you may have about your child. She can discuss and offer advice or signpost you to other health services. You just need to come to the front office during the times advertised and we will show you through to the meeting room.</p>

	<p><b>Vacancy for Kitchen Assistant</b></p> <p>We will have a vacancy for a temporary kitchen assistant. The post will start September and cover maternity leave. The role will need a Food Health and Hygiene Certificate Qualification and we can provide training for you to attain this prior to starting the role, if you are the successful candidate. The rate of pay will be the living wage of £7.90 per hour, 10 hours per week. The hours of work will be 8:15am to 10:15am, term time only. You will need to be reliable and hardworking and able to take direction from the school cook, Mrs Picker. If you are interested, please collect and complete an application form from the school office and return before Friday 23rd June 9.00am.</p>
