Pupil Premium Grant Expenditure Report to Parents: Plans for 2015/2016

The government decided to give extra money to schools to support children they wanted to do better. They decided that if a family was eligible for free school meals, or had been eligible for free school meals within the previous 6 years, they would give the school more money. For each eligible child the school got £1320.00.

The money was based on children eligible in January 2015.

The money was allocated to schools in the budget from April 2015 to March 2016.
